**Task Force on Tax Assistance for the Resource Regions
and the New Economy**

**In Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean
on Thursday, September 27, 2007**

Québec, September 25, 2007 – The Task Force on Tax Assistance for the Resource Regions and the New Economy will continue its work at the Hôtel et Centre des congrès le Montagnais in Saguenay on Thursday, September 27, 2007.

The first part of the meetings will take place in private from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. A period of public hearings will follow, beginning at 2:30 p.m.

The Québec government set up the Task Force on June 27, 2007. Its mandate is to assess the tax assistance for the resource regions and the new economy and its impact, as well as to propose new avenues for the development of the specific territories and activity sectors concerned. The Task Force will submit its recommendations to the government in December 2007. The Task Force is chaired by Robert Gagné; the other two members are Luc Godbout and Guy Lacroix.
